

## Right size Guidance



## Rings

Ring sizing chart for measuring your finger size appropriately.

This is a chart that will assist you in determining the ring size that you require. To measure the area that will be occupied by the ring, you can use tape or a little piece of string. When it reaches the end of the line, it is said to be a full circle.

This will make it easier for you to compare the chart with the one below. You can add another size to accommodate extra breadth.

### Step 1 -

- Cut a thin strip of paper or Thread
- Wrap the paper/Thread around your finger.
- Mark the spot where the paper/Thread meets



### Step 2 -

- Measure the length of the thread with your ruler.
- Use the following chart to determine your ring size.





Another chart to check while deciding the proper ring size is the one below. Take the inside diameter of a ring you already own and multiply it by two. It is a millimetre scale that measures the interior diameter of a ring. This one is generally used to double-check results from the traditional paper approach.


## Bangles

Measure your Bangle size rightly!

The table below will assist you in determining your exact bracelet size. You'll need a measuring tape or thread, as well as a scale, to measure your hand. As illustrated in the image, bring your thumb and little finger together and measure where your hand is the widest.

#### Option 1:

- Using a small strip of thread or paper, make a loop.
- Make a fist with your thumb and little finger.
- Wrap your hand where it is the widest.
- Make a mark where the thread/paper ends will meet.



## Option 2:

Measure the length of the thread with your scale.



### Chains

Choose the Right Length

Consider the length of a necklace or pendant when choosing one. It will determine where it will fall on your chest.

For Female:



- 14in. Fits most like a choker
- 16 in.

  Just above collarbones. Emphasizes your neckline.
- 18 in. Hangs over collarbones. The most common length.
- 20 in.

  Perfect for a low, plunging neckline or if you want to wear it over a turtleneck.
- 22in.
  Falls at or above a low neckline.
- 24 in.
  Falls at or above a low neckline. Over blouse or dress. A dramatic length.
- 36 in.

  They can be worn as a single strand or you can double them for an 18 inch necklace.

\*Please keep in mind that these are all approximations for an average woman's or man's height and size. Larger people will need longer lengths and petite ones will need shorter lengths.

For male:



- 18 in.
  - A shorter length that falls just around the base of the neck.
- 20 in.

A common length for men which falls right at the collarbone. Pendants will hide under a crew neck or show completely with a low v-neck or unbuttoned dress shirt.

- 22 in.
  - Falls a few inches below a collar bone and can be worn over or under a shirt
- 24 in. Extra long, falls just above the sternum.

\*Please keep in mind that these are all approximations for an average woman's or man's height and size. Larger people will need longer lengths and petite ones will need shorter lengths.
